Can I Fly Privacy policy 1

Your online privacy is important to "Can I Fly". The purpose of this privacy statement is to provide you with information about our practices with respect to the personal data that we collect from users of our website (hereafter referred to as "Site") and the services that are made available through the Site. Please email us at support@canifly.in if you have any questions concerning our privacy statement, our data collection policies, how we handle user information, or if you want to immediately report a security breach.

What this policy is for:

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) applies to the whole of the United State and European union (EU) companies holding data of United States and European union (EU) citizens. We value your privacy and want to be accountable to you, and transparent with you, in the way that we collect and use your personal information. We also want you to know your rights in relation to your personal information.

"The canifly.in" ("We" / "Us" / "Our") is committed to protecting our visitors' privacy and personal information. We will only use the information that we collect about you in accordance with the California online privacy policy Act or "CalOPPa" (and all other laws relating to the use of your Personal Data, both now and in the future). This includes information that is submitted voluntarily by you through a form on our website or that is gathered automatically as you visit different parts of this website.

This page aims to help users understand what information might be collected from you when visiting and using our site, and how we protect such information. The reason for this is that, in keeping with the "CalOPPa" (and all other laws relating to the use of your Personal Data, both now and in the future), we are the "data controller", meaning that we are responsible for deciding how your Personal Data is used and more importantly, for keeping your Personal Data safe and only using it for legitimate reasons.

1. What Information we collect

The canifly in actively collects information from its visitors directly from you when you: create an online account, create a search, sign up to our newsletter, give a rating or review, take a survey, fill out an online form, enter a promotion or engage with us.

Some information you submit may be personally identifiable information that can be uniquely identified with you such as full name, address or location, email address, phone number, etc. Some areas of the Site may require you to submit information in order for you to benefit from a

wide range of exclusive features (such as email alerts or information requests). You will be informed at each information collection point on what information is required and optional.

We collect the following information from you and about you:

- **Contact Information** We may ask about your personal information such as name, address or location, telephone or mobile number, or email address.
- **Account Login Information** We will require you to provide information to set up an account with us.
- Log Files: As is true of most websites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes IP addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data. We use this information to maintain and improve the performance of the Services.
- Analytics: We use analytics services (including, but not limited to, Google Analytics) to help analyze how users use the Site. Analytics services use Cookies to collect information such as how often users visit the Site and we use the information to improve our Site and Services. The analytics services' ability to use and share information collected by them is restricted by their terms of use and privacy policy, which you should refer to for more information about how these entities use this information.
- Location Information: If you have enabled location services on your mobile device, we may collect your location information to improve the Services we offer. This enables us to provide location-based services. If you wish to change our access or permissions, you may do so in your device's settings.

2. Use of Your Personal information

In general, personal information you submit to us is used either to respond to requests that you make, aid us in serving you better, or market our Services. We use your personal information in the following ways:

- Operate, maintain, and improve our site(s) services;
- Respond to comments and questions and provide customer service;
- Develop, improve and advertising our podcast Services;
- Fulfill and manage our service, payments, and other transactions related to the Application;

Your personal information may be kept and processed on servers in the United State and Europe. We may also create anonymous data records from your personal information by completely excluding information (such as your name) that makes the data personally

identifiable to you. We use this anonymous data to analyze request and usage patterns so that we may enhance the content of our Services and improve Site functionality. We reserve the right to use anonymous data for any purpose and disclose anonymous data to third parties at our sole discretion.

3. Disclosure of Your Personal information

We disclose your personal information as described below and as described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy.

Third Parties Designated by You: When you use the Services, the personal information you provide will be shared with the third parties that you authorize to receive such information.

Services; and/or to provide other services to us.

Information We Share: We may disclose aggregated information about our users and information that does not identify any individual without restriction. In addition, we may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide:

- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it, for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information, or with your consent;
- To third parties designated by you;
- With our subsidiaries and affiliates;

4. Third Party Websites

Our Site may contain links to third party websites. When you click on a link to any other website or location, you automatically exit our Site or Services and go to another site, and another entity may collect personal information or anonymous data from you. We have no control over, do not review, and are not responsible for, these outside websites or their contents. Please, be aware that the terms of this Privacy Policy, do not apply to these outside websites or contents, or to any collection of your personal information after you click on links to such outside websites. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of every website you visit. The links to third party websites or locations are for your convenience and do not signify our endorsement of such third parties or, content or websites.

5. Your Choices Regarding Information

Choices: We offer you choices regarding the collection, use, and sharing of your personal information. We may periodically send you emails that directly promote the use of our Services. When you receive promotional communications from us, you may indicate a preference to stop receiving further communications from us and you will have the opportunity to "opt-out" by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the email you receive or by contacting us directly. Despite your indicated email preferences, we may send you service-related communications, including notices of any updates to our Terms of Use or Privacy Policy.

6. Your Rights

As a user of our Site, you have the following rights, any of which you may exercise by contacting us at support@canifly.in The right to ask what personal data that we hold about you at any time. Extra requests (particularly repetitive) for data may result in a fee being charged to the user.

Standard Security

We use standard security measures on our site. We will treat your information in strict confidence and endeavour to take all reasonable steps to protect your personal information. However, we cannot guarantee the security of any data you disclose online. You accept inherent security risks of providing information and other internet activities and will not hold us responsible for any breach of security unless it is due to our negligence or willful default.

We keep personal information as long as it is necessary for the practices described in this Policy. We also keep information as otherwise required by law.

California Online Privacy Protection Act (CalOPPA)

CalOPPA is the first state law in the country to mandate the posting of a privacy statement on commercial websites and online services. The law's reach extends well beyond California, requiring anyone or any organization operating websites in the United States (or perhaps the entire world) that collect personally identifiable information from California consumers to post a clear privacy statement on their website, adhere to it, and disclose exactly what information is being collected and with whom it will be shared.

According to CalOPPA we agree to the following:

Cookie Usage
